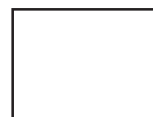
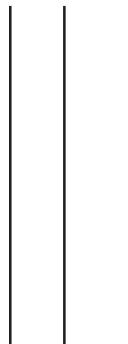

# WHAT'S WRONG with Waxman's **THOUGHT CONTROL** BILL, H.R. 984?

Rep. Henry Waxman's *Executive Branch Reform Act*, H.R. 984, would erode citizens' involvement in the democratic process--- shattering free engagement from the grassroots level to thousands of employees of the executive branch of government.

Waxman's bill labels every American a "citizen lobbyist" whose comments or suggestions to the federal government must be recorded and then made public! If his bill passes, Joe. Q. Citizen will no longer provide a welcome source of input to the government. Rather, only Waxman and select colleagues (primarily in Congress, the intelligence community, and the military) will be allowed to communicate freely to each other.

H.R. 984 will require all members of the executive branch to record every call from concerned citizens. Over 9,000 federal employees must keep records of any conversations that might be construed as desiring to influence national policy-- even conversations during work, at a bar afterwards, or with their spouses in bed! Their records must include names, dates, and detailed

information about the content of each conversation.

Every quarter these federal employees must file a mountain of documentation with the government. Failure to report accurately and on time, means, at minimum, loss of their job. It can also result in a \$50,000 fine.

**The federal government will then take this data (without permission) and publish it for the world to see.** This, Waxman contends, is "openness in government."

H.R. 984 means the government, which should be responsive to free petition, comment, and criticism, will find its paperwork obligations so burdensome that the only way to govern will be by isolation from the American people.

This sinister legislation sabotages free exchange between citizens and those who govern, helping create a "big brother" police state. The government will know everything about us, while we will be afraid to raise our heads and comment for fear of even greater federal control over our lives.

WAY TOO MUCH GOVERNMENT POWER!

In the years preceding the communist

takeovers in Russia, China, and Cuba, revolutionaries quietly gathered names and detailed personal information of every potential opponent. When revolution finally came, they knew exactly whom to liquidate. The Anti-Defamation League, architect of speech-restricting legislation worldwide, has a long and tawdry history of gathering, secretly and illegally, the names of tens of thousands of its political opponents. Rep. Waxman is part of ADL's inner circle.

After 20 years of lobbying efforts, ADL took away free speech in Canada in 1971 through passage of their federal "anti-hate" law. ADL wants to enact similar speech crime legislation in America to accomplish the same Orwellian goal.

Last year, a Canadian "citizen lobbyist" emailed criticisms of Canada's immigration policies to his member of Parliament. The MP had him indicted under ADL's hate law. This is the kind of "speech control" and much worse which ADL and insiders like Waxman envision for America.
